## WORLD'S BEST CASK GIN

*World Gin Awards, London*



Valentine Liberator Old Tom Gin, named after the B-24 Liberator Heavy Bomber produced in Detroit during WW II, is made from a blend of nine unique botanicals, including juniper, orange peel and cardamom. It is then aged in New American Oak barrels for up to 2 years.

### WHAT IS OLD TOM GIN?

Old Tom Gin dates back to the 18th century and served as a bridge between the malty style of that era's Genevers and the late 19th century taste for the biting and dry style of London Dry. Old Tom Gins varied so widely that no clear classification exists today. Valentine Distilling embraces the historic method of pot distillation and replicates the former method of transportation in oak barrels, which softens the distillate as well as adds color and deep flavor.

### Tasting Notes:

Aromas of juniper and pine that is well-balanced by hints of oak, woody spices and citrus peel. The initial bursts of juniper berries are mellow and tame, and are followed by touches of vanilla, citrus, cardamom and cinnamon.

### Awards & Accolades:

Liberator Old Tom Gin won the title of 'World's Best Cask Gin' from the World Gin Awards. It also earned a Gold Medal from the International Craft Spirit Awards. Rated 4 stars 'Highly Recommended' by F. Paul Pacault.
