Valentine Liberator Gin, named after the B-24 Liberator Heavy Bomber produced in Detroit during WW II, is made from a blend of nine unique botanicals, including juniper, orange peel and cardamon.

Flavors are imparted with two alembic distillations. Earthy notes such as juniper, cardamon and coriander are macerated for up to 48 hours, while lighter notes of citrus are imparted through the use of a botanical vessel, where the vapors pass over natural ingredients

Tasting Notes:

Attractive aromas of peppery cinnamon, honey cardamom pastry, dried citrus, and candied juniper with a silky, dry-yet-fruity medium-to-full body and a zesty mélange of citrus, herbal roots, anise, pink peppercorn, and cinnamon bark on the long finish. A well balanced and spice forward gin for all applications.

Awards & Accolades:

Liberator Gin earned the Gold Medal and the title, 'Best American Gin' winning both "Best in Class" and "Best in Show" at the American Distilling Institute's 7th Annual Judging of Craft Spirits. In addition, it earned a score of 90 points from the Beverage Testing Institute in 2013 and a Gold Medal from the International Craft Spirit Awards, and the prestigious 'Best American Gin Distillery' from Berlin International Spirit Awards.
